This notice is an update on the recent federal and state executive orders issued by the President (<u>Click Here</u> to view President's Guidelines) and the Governor of Florida (<u>Click Here</u> to view Governor's order).

## Florida Beaches

- 1. "Parties accessing the public beaches in the State of Florida are to follow the CDC guidance by limiting their gatherings to no more than 10 persons, distance themselves from other parties by 6 feet, and support beach closures at the discretion of local authorities." State of Florida, Governor Executive Order 20-68, Section 2.
- 2. Brevard County has just closed all beachside **<u>public</u>** parking. Aquarina beach parking is still open to residents with vehicles/golf carts displaying Aquarina stickers. <u>Click Here</u> to view County notice.

AGI is following all of the same mandates. Please follow their separate messages on golf, tennis and the restaurant. We are all expected to follow these mandates. The governor's office is considering issuing fines for noncompliance.

We ask that the Presidents and officers of the HOA sub communities make an effort to validate that your residents are aware of these mandates.
