Dear Friends and Neighbors,

This notice is an Aquarina update related to COVID-19 and to inform you that one of our Aquarina residents has been hospitalized to rule out COVID-19. To clarify, this person is not yet a confirmed case but is under hospital care for treatment of suspected symptoms and is awaiting the results of lab testing.

What does that mean to you and all of Aquarina? We all need to adhere to a heightened awareness and compliance with personal safety behaviors. Residents, guests, visitors, renters and employees need to follow the CDC Coronavirus Guidelines to reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus. <u>www.Coronavirus.gov</u>

1. *****Emergency Alert sent to all Floridians Cell Phones on 3/28/2020 at 4:20pm: "FL Surgeon General: Stay home if 65+ or have medical conditions. All follow all social distancing."

2. ******If anyone in Aquarina has travelled from the tri-state region of New York, New Jersey and/or Connecticut you are required by the Florida Governor's mandate to self-quarantine (i.e. stay in your house) and to self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days which starts on day of arrival to Florida, under penalty of the law, type 2 misdemeanor subject to jail time and fines. <u>https://www.flgov.com/wpcontent/uploads/orders/2020/EO_20-82.pdf</u>

3. *****Anyone living in Aquarina (residents, renters, guests) who has a confirmed case of COVID-19 <u>should self-report to ASCA COVID-19 Task Force by emailing to</u> <u>aquarinacovid@gmail.com</u>. Necessary information includes name, address, date diagnosis was confirmed and what common areas within Aquarina properties you have been in for the previous 10 days. This information will help determine if we need to take any additional safety measures such as industrial cleaning of said areas for the safety of the community and to reduce the spread.

4. ACSA with the COVID-19 task force will continue to monitor the CDC, County, State and national recommendations and will take the steps necessary to keep our community as safe as possible. *Additional* steps we are taking at this time are:

a. Beach Club house deck will be closed until further notice

b. Brassie Grill patio is closed with all furniture removed

5. There will be no sitting, standing or congregating of **any persons** on Aquarina common areas or properties >10 persons and must be at least 6 feet apart.

6. Anyone with any of the symptoms of COVID19 by CDC guidelines need to call their physician immediately, self-monitor and quarantine (**STAY INSIDE YOUR HOUSE**) for 14 days. Those living within the same house must also quarantine for 14 days.

7. Anyone with known contact with a person with COVID-19 or a person suspected of COVID-19 must self-monitor and stay home.
