

CHANGES FROM AGI

Dear Residents:

Due to a shortage of kitchen personnel, the Brassie Grille will need to limit its hours of operation. The **Brassie will move to a** <u>**Tuesday - Saturday**</u> five day work week effective immediately and continue until we can adequately staff the kitchen. Our liquor license restricts us from offering bar service without food service, so we cannot keep the bar open exclusively.

Following the CDC recommendation, the restaurant will serve food and beverages <u>Tuesday - Saturday</u> outdoors on the patio area for increased ventilation. The Brassie wait staff will verbally communicate the daily offerings to reduce the touch points that occur with customers handling menus. Carry out service is available <u>Tuesday - Saturday</u>.

Golf operations will remain open seven days a week. We will not provide water on the golf course from the coolers, so please bring you own water when playing. We apologize, but we don't want touching of a common container. Our golf carts are wiped down after each use.

- Sandpipers will move to Wednesdays - As previously announced, Nine and Dine (outdoors) will be on Thursdays

If you need to purchase the water or a soft drink from the refrigerated cooler in the golf or tennis pro shop, ask the staff to obtain it. We don't want the cooler to be self serve during this period.
