

Quarantine - Mandated \*Strict stay in the house orders with penalties and fines

 Those with confirmed COVID-19 and those living within the household

Those with symptoms awaiting test results



 Those traveling from NY, NJ and/or Connecticut (14 days from day of arrival)

# COVID-19

Mask Use – Recent updates



- 1. CDC Guidelines addition last week
- Those exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 that have no symptoms can return to work with mask and monitoring
- 2. Florida Mandates with penalties and fines
- County, cities and municipalities of South Florida – Miami-Dade and Palm Counties
- Osceola County 3 days ago, everyone in public with these exceptions: <2 yrs of age, people with health conditions in no tolerance for face covering, professionals having no face: face, exercising outdoors with 6' distance maintained

Mask Use – Recent updates



### Clarifications – Mask Use in our location

- Who should wear a mask/face coverings:
  - Those is contact with COVID 19 patients
  - People with COVID 19 and COVID like symptoms
  - People at high risk to catch should wear a mask
- There are no CDC, FDA or OSHA specific COVID 19 recommendations for face mask in food services unless
  - exposed to a confirmed case of COVID 19
  - are in counties mandated masks for everyone in public
- Those exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 that have no symptoms can return to work with mask/face coverings and monitoring

Rumor Control Q&A At this time, there are no national/FL state/Brevard county mandates on closing golf courses or pools so long as CDC guidelines are followed
