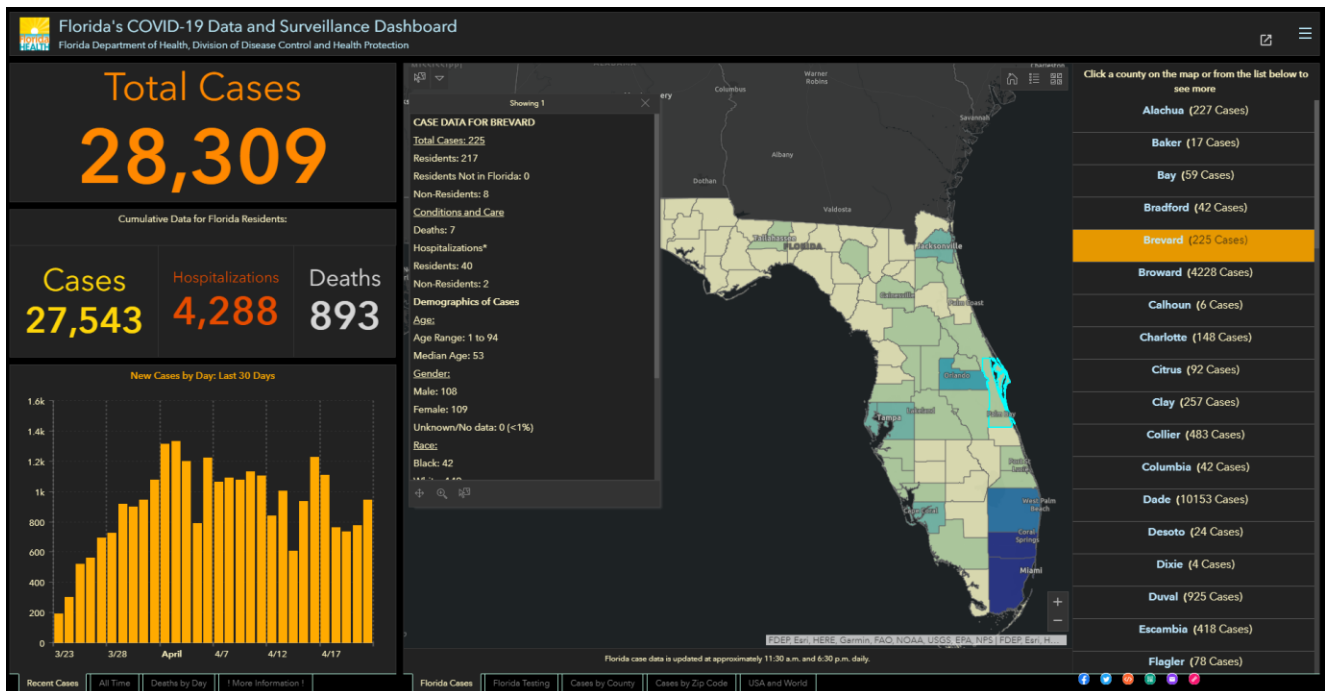


Dear Residents and Neighbors,

We are all anxious for the COVID-19 limitations to be lifted so we can reopen all services and amenities in Aquarina. We are committed to monitoring daily the recommendations and mandates that apply to us and as well as reopening our common facilities as soon as it has been deemed safe to do so. It is important that we follow these recommendations and mandates to reduce both the risk of transmission as well as the liability to our community.

On Monday, Governor Ron DeSantis convened a Re-Open Florida Task Force. Meetings on this topic began Monday afternoon and will continue throughout the week. An initial plan to reopen is expected this Friday, April 24th.

New cases in Florida and Brevard County are still being identified daily but at a slower rate, with our Governor stating that [Florida's curve](#) has begun to flatten. The latest CDC recommendations to the States for reopening into "Stage I" can be taken once 14 consecutive days of decline in new cases is demonstrated.
