Dear Residents and Neighbors,

Florida's Plan to Reopen, as announced by Governor Ron DeSantis, goes into effect today, Monday, May 4th. In accordance with the state's plan, our ACSA committees and AGI have developed plans to reopen the services and amenities that can meet the new guidelines. Aquarina Tennis has opened with a safety plan and the Bassie Restaurant will begin outdoor service today. Please refer to AGI's separate email communications that were sent out last week and earlier today.

As we reopen services, we ask that you to continue making the right decisions for your own safety and the safety of others. Below is a summary of the Governor's recent executive order. The areas highlighted are of particular note for all of us in Aquarina. People who are vulnerable need to be especially careful.

Executive Order 20-112:

Phase 1: Safe, Smart, Step-By-Step Plan to Reopen Florida will begin on Monday, May 4 and includes:

- Schools remain distance learning.
- Visits to senior living facilities are prohibited.
- Elective surgeries can resume.
- Restaurants may offer outdoor seating with 6-foot space between tables and indoor seating at 25% capacity.
- Retail can operate at 25% of indoor capacity.
- No change for bars, gyms and personal services such as hairdressers.
- Vulnerable individuals should avoid close contact with people outside the home.
- All individuals, when in public, should maximize physical distance from others.
- Avoid socializing in group of more than 10 people in circumstances that do not readily allow for physical distancing.
- Face masks are recommended for all those in face-to-face interactions and where you can't social distance.

Aquarina Common Properties

Beach Club: The Beach Clubhouse will remain closed, but the clubhouse *deck* will reopen for use, *Wednesday, May 6th* with the following guidelines:

- Social distancing needs to be observed.
- The furniture will include tables with one half of the normal number of chairs.
- Furniture is not to be moved; please do not push tables and chairs together.

- You will need to wipe down the furniture with a disinfectant wipe before using.
- Use at your own risk.

Aquarina Gym and Community Center: Both of the facilities will remain closed for now in accordance with the Executive Order.

All properties and services will continue to be assessed as additional state guidelines are released.

General Safety

During the Florida Stay at Home Orders, more people than usual for this time of year, have been with us in Aquarina. The Board and COVID-19 Task Force have received numerous comments and concerns regarding residents, visitors and/or renters (of all ages) who seem to be unaware of how Aquarina safely operates.

Dogs should always be on a leash and pet owners are responsible to clean up after their pets and are asked to place waste in their own trash containers. Please remember to not leave valuables or personal belongings unattended or unsecure – no matter the location or length of time. Lock and secure vehicles, golf carts, and bicycles. Walkers, dogs, bikes, and fishermen have been noted on golf cart paths during times when golfers are out. This creates unnecessary safety risks for everyone. Only golfers and employees should be on the course and cart paths during hours of operation. Aquarina owners/residents are asked to clearly communicate all related policies, guidelines and these notices with guests and renters. This will help ensure everyone's safety and the best use of our community.
