Dear Residents and Neighbors,

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that there is an Aquarina resident residing in the community who has tested positive for COVID-19. This resident has not traveled out of the surrounding area for several months and is not aware of being in contact with an active case. Therefore, this case is most likely to have been contracted locally, but we have no idea where.

Out of concern for our community, this resident immediately began home isolation, reached out to recent contacts, and the COVID-19 Task Force. We appreciate this person's concern for the greater Aquarina Community. This information provides us with the opportunity to access our individual and group activities to help mitigate our risks. Out of an abundance of caution, we have closed the Aquarina gym and the Community Center for deep cleaning as these are the community spaces this resident used more recently. These spaces and activities will resume as soon as possible with safe reopening plans to be announced by next week.

If you have concerns and/or symptoms, you can contact your physician and/or google "Brevard County COVID19 testing sites" and choose a location for having a COVID-19 test with or without a physician's order. There are many testing locations in Brevard County including one of the closest being the CVS pharmacy drive through on Miramar and A1A in Indialantic.

Everyone should be aware of their own individual risks and take the appropriate precautions. Masks, social distancing, good and frequent hand washing and limiting large group activities are still considered the best preventive measures for limiting the spread of this disease. We wish this resident a quick recovery and thank them for their concern for the greater Aquarina Community.

Be smart, follow the guidelines and be safe.
