Dear Residents and Neighbors,

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that we have been made aware of three new positive COVID19 cases here in Aquarina. These three individuals all live in the same condo building and did have contact with each other during the recent holidays.

All three give the history of remaining local and having used masks and hand hygiene appropriately. Their COVID19 source is likely to remain unknown. The Ocean Dunes board is working on a plan to address their common spaces and are encouraging all residents and guests to take precautions and follow the CDC guidelines. Those who may have had contact with these individuals have already been notified. With the number of cases throughout Florida and the country, including the unknown number of unreported and/or asymptomatic cases, it is very likely that there are additional active cases within Aquarina.

It is worth noting that all three of these people were tested at Surfside Urgent Care on 192 (5th Ave) in Indialantic. Because of the quick diagnosis and referral to Holmes Emergency Department, they all received antibody infusion therapy on the date of diagnosis which might lessen the severity and course of their illness. We wish them all a speedy recovery.

Regarding COVID19 vaccines:

1. Bill Devanney, our resident pharmacist who together with Publix, sponsored the Aquarina flu clinic, shared that they might be able to provide us with a COVID19 vaccine clinic in February or March when vaccinations with less refrigeration storage requirements are available. We will keep you posted.
2. Omni Health and the Brevard County Department of Health are both offering the COVID19 vaccines to individuals that meet the State of Florida's priority list. You need to register online but all available dates/times for Brevard County appointments are filled at this time. Omni Health has a phone number that is included in the link below.
